### Children's Miracle Network

### Clubhouse

The thermostat in the clubhouse still needs repair. An electrician has been called. A new clock was purchased for the outside for those in the pool and at water aerobics.

### Lockwood Lines

The Lines has gone to press and will be mailed on or about May 17. Names of residents delinquent in their dues were removed from the mailing list.

### July 4<sup>th</sup> Party

Plans for a July 4<sup>th</sup> community party were discussed.

### Boat Storage

There are one or two openings in the boat storage area. Gravel for the lot will be included in a future budget.

### Roads/Infrastructure

Improvements on Fairway Ct. 3 and Marshview Drive and filling in potholes were discussed. Joe met with the representatives of St. James to discuss the USDA application. That process is moving forward.

### Current Budget

With about six weeks left in this fiscal year, we are on budget.

### Board Elections

We approved the sample ballot. The ballots will be mailed next week. Residents 90 days delinquent will not receive ballots.

### Storm Water Management

Next fiscal year's focus will be on the Lockwood Lane and Clubhouse Drive and the Lockwood Lane and Genoe's Point intersections. The pump for irrigation in the pond on Clubhouse Drive near Hole 10 was returned, credit was issued, a new pump will be purchased.
