-It was also voted on to donate \$100.00 to Kathy's Angels for material for the quilts they make for our residents when they are ill or injured. Several members asked if we could know who to contact if a quilt is needed and who they are disbursed to during the year.

-Linda Balduc and Ann Boileau volunteered to audit the Women's Club financial books in August.

-Water Aerobics will begin when the pool water reaches 80 degrees. Pam will put out a notice.

-The Women's Club will send Sharlene Ackley a "Thank You" note for her hard work on the beautification of our neighborhood.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:50 for our speaker, Victoria Kling, Emergency Services Director of the Cape Fear Chapter of the American Red Cross, who told us what we need to do to get ready for evacuation for hurricanes and provided us with many booklets.
